The City of Galena understands that shelter in place requirements are more difficult for some to follow than others and may provide options for those that need additional resources (shopping, lodging, package pick-ups). Please inquire with the travel coordinator if you need assistance.

Definitions:

Shelter in Place means and requires remaining in a place of residence or lodging as much as possible and not going to any public places and/or gatherings, this includes all members of your household and children in your residency cannot attend public school, until post travel testing of traveler(s) is complete and results are negative.

Significant Exposure means having contact within six feet, for a duration of 10 minutes or more with in a close space with no masks. If you or members of your household have close personal contact with others who are under shelter in place, you are now also subject to that same mandate until such time as they have tested negative, or gone 14 days with no symptoms.
