The City of Galena understands that shelter in place requirements may be particularly difficult for some persons, and may be able to provide options for those that need additional resources. Please inquire with the travel coordinator if you need assistance.

Emergency Ordinance 2021-06 & GMC 8.12.065 require persons to wear masks in all public places.

Emergency Ordinance 2021-08 and GMC 8.12.020 require all non-exempt persons arriving in Galena to either:

1. Obtain a COVID-19 Test not more than 72 hours prior to arrival in Galena (you may travel before receiving the result) and then shelter-in-place until you obtain a negative result on a second test taken, in Galena, not less than 7 days after the test taken before arrival; or
2. Shelter in place in Galena for 14 days following arrival.

"Shelter-in-place" means and requires remaining in a place of residence or lodging as much as possible, not shopping to the extent possible, and not going to any places of public accommodation, and confining separately from all other individuals, including individuals in the place of residence or lodging, unless those individuals are also sheltering-in-place for the same duration. Shelter-in-place does not prohibit outdoor exercise or walking of pets, provided that the person required to shelter-in-place maintains a distance of six feet or more from other persons.

Emergency Ordinance 2021-11 requires persons arriving into the City of Galena from any other municipality or census-designated place, whether by air, land, or water, to complete and submit this form.
