At our Task Force meeting held on Thursday, July 30, 2020, we decided to extend our Lockdown until Monday, August 10, 2020. This includes all Inter-Village Travel. We will allow Essential and Medical travel, provided that proper travel paperwork is submitted along with negative Covid-19 test. All incoming travelers are mandated to quarantine for 14 days, 2 weeks.


The river patrol will continue to monitor the riverbank, with strict instructions to turn away all travelers (absolutely no exceptions).

This grace period is to ensure that Nulato residents are healthy and are showing no signs of COVID-19. If anyone shows any of the following signs: coughing, fever above 100 degrees, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, please contact the Nulato Clinic immediately.

After the grace period, if there are no risks of exposure, we will reopen non-essential travel that has been approved by the task force. The task force will meet on Thursday, August 6, 2020 to determine whether Nulato is safe to reopen or if it is necessary to remain closed for travel.
