KIYU Community Service Achievements Scholarship Requirements for Eligibility

Hello! All graduating seniors of the Yukon-Koyukuk region and KIYU listing area, are invited to apply for the KIYU Community Service Achievements Scholarship. There are a few simple qualifications to meet in order to be eligible. We understand every circumstance is different, but in the interest of fairness, please be aware exceptions will very rarely be granted to these rules.

Scholarship funds to be awarded: _____Up to \$2,000 with a minimum of \$1,000

- 1. Student must be a senior anticipating a spring graduation.
- 2. Student must have maintained a 3.0 GPA or higher throughout their Junior and Senior years in high school.
- 3. Student must plan to attend college or technical school the semester following high school graduation.
- 4. To prove a commitment to school, all semi-finalists may be asked to be interviewed, if the deciding board deems necessary.
- 5. Students should be able to produce three (2) letters of recommendation.
- 6. Student must submit a typed essay detailing the act of community service to be judged for this scholarship. Community service acts can be a group activity in which you participated, such as debris pick-up. Or, it can be something you accomplished on your own, such as assisting an elder with home projects at any point in your high school career. Please remember to explain the importance and impact of your service to the community.
- Submit your letters of reference and essay, personally or by mail, to KIYU, along with the accompanying application **no later than May 17th, 2024**. Mailed entries must be postmarked by this date.

The final decision will be made on June 1^{st} , 2024 at 6:00 PM. The winner will be notified by phone at that time.
